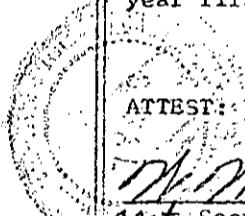


21. This lease shall be binding upon and inure to the benefit of the parties hereto, their respective heirs, executors, administrators, successors and assigns. However, this lease may not be assigned by the Lessee, except upon the written consent of the Lessors. No change in the ownership of the lands shall in any way operate to defeat or change the terms and covenants of this lease.

22. This lease shall supersede and cancel, as of its effective date, that certain written lease agreement dated November 1, 1957, between the Lessors and Campbell Limestone Company, now Vulcan Materials Company.

23. The effective date of this lease shall be MAY 1st, 1973.
