successors and assigns, forever:

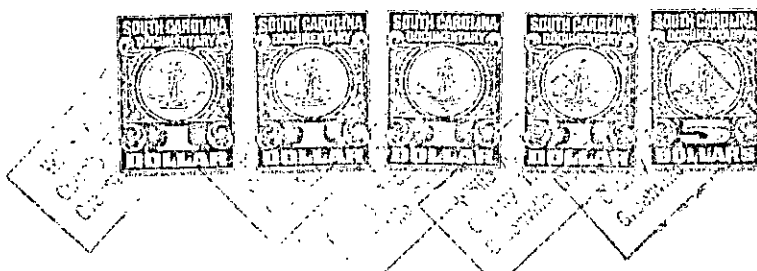
All those certain pieces, parcels or lots of land, situate, lying
