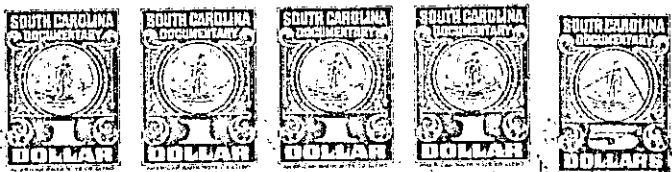
all that piece, parcel or lot of land in Glassy Mountain Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina
