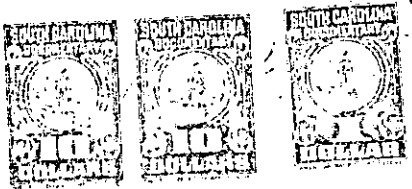
TO ALL TO WHOM THESE PRESENTS SHALL COME:
