CONTRACT FOR DEED

THIS AGREEMENT made and entered into this 10th day of January, 1973, by and between Robert L. Perry, III of Greenville County, South Carolina, hereinafter called the Seller, and Frances T. Wyatt, hereinafter called the Buyer.
