hereinafter called "Grantor" (whether one or more), and DUKE POWER COMPANY, a North Carolina corporation, hereinafter called "Grantoe",

WITNESSETH:

That Granter, in consideration of \$16.00 Canada paid by Grantee, the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, does grant and convey unto Grantee, its successors and assigns, subject to the limitations hereinaftor described, the right to erect, construct, reconstruct, replace, maintain and use towers, poles, wires, lines, cables, and all necessary and proper foundations, footings, crossarms and other appliances and fixtures for the purpose of transmitting electric power and for Grantee's communication purposes, togother with a right of way, on, along and in all of the hereinafter described tract(s) of land lying and being

Greenville County, South Carolina, and more particularly described as follows:

Being a strip of land 200 feet wide extending 100 feet on northwesterly side and 100 feet on the southeasterly side of a survey line which has been marked on the ground and is approximately 2640.8 feet long and lies across the land of the Grantor (in one or more sections).

The land of the Grantor over which said rights and easements are granted is a part of the property described in the following deed(s) from James W. Moses recorded in Book 496..., page 84....

Transmission Line, dated June 13, 1969, marked file No. 44-129, copy of which is attached hereto and made a part hereof.

Grantor, for the consideration aforesaid, further grants to Grantee (1) the right at any time to clear said strip and keep said strip clear of any or all structures, trees, fire hazards, or other objects of any nature; (2) the right at any time to make relocations, changes, renewals, substitutions and additions on or to said structures within said strip; (3) the right from time to time to trim, fell, and clear away any trees on the property of the Granter outside of said strip which now or hereafter may be a hazard to said towers, poles, wires, cables, or other apparatus or appliances by reason of the danger of falling thereon; (4) the right of lugress to and egenss from said strip ever and across the other lands of the Grantor by means of existing roads and lones thereon, adjacent thanto, or crossing said strip; otherwise by such route or routes as shall occorden the least presidents damage and incontinuous to Gronor, provided, that such right of ingress and egross shall not ostend to gay portion of send leads a high it superated from said strip by any public road or highway, now creasing or her other crossing and lands.
