in consideration of SIX THOUSAND and NO/100 (\$6,000.00)----- Dollars,

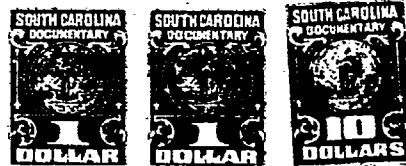

All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land, with the buildings and improvements thereon, lying and being on the northeasterly side of East Indian Trail, near the City of Greenville, S.
