The Lessee shall not remove, or permit the removal of, any of the Leased Equipment from the Leased Land except in accordance with the provisions of this Section.

Section 6.3. Taxes, Other Governmental Charges and

Utility Charges. The County and the Lessee acknowledge (i)

that pursuant to Section 13 of the Act, no part of the Project

owned by the County will be subject to taxation in South Carolina,

(ii) that under present law the income and profits (if any)

of the County from the Project are not subject to either Federal

or South Carolina taxation, (iii) that under present law there

is no tax imposed upon leasehold estates in South Carolina,

and (iv) that these factors, among others, have induced the

Lessee to enter into this Agreement.

However, the Lessee will pay, as the same become due, all taxes and governmental charges of any kind whatsoever that may at any time be lawfully assessed or levied against or with respect to the Project or any machinery, equipment or other property installed or brought by the Lessee therein or thereon (including, without limiting the generality of the foregoing, any taxes levied upon or with respect to the lease rentals, revenues or receipts of the County from the Project which, if not paid, will become a charge on the revenues and receipts therefrom prior to or on a parity with the charge thereon and the pleage or assignment thereof to be created and made in the Assignment, and including all ad valorem cakes. lawfully assessed upon the leadqueld estate hereby granted and cenveyed to the Legger in the Leaged Land, building and Legged liquitment), all utility and other charges incurred in the operation, maintenance, une, occupancy and upkeep of the Project and all appengments and charach lawfully made by any governmental body for public improvements that may be secured by lien on the Project; provided, that with respect to special assessments or other governmental charges that may lawfully be paid in installments over a period of years, the Lessee shall be obliquted to pay such installments only as they become due.
