The Congregational meeting, held on August 26 immediately following the 11:00 Service, was presided over by Dr. Charles Mies, vice-chairman of the congregation.

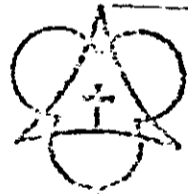
The meeting was called to order and the following recommendations presented:

1. That in lieu of housing provided by Trinity Lutheran Church, Pastor Trexler be offered the option of a housing allowance of \$4,200.00 annually.
2. That Pastor Trexler have the privilege of exercising this option at his discretion.
3. That if and when Pastor Trexler exercises this option to take the allowance in lieu of church provided housing, the church council be empowered to sell the present parsonage and invest the proceeds from the sale.

The motion to accept the recommendations was made by Mr. Jimmy Jones, seconded by Mrs. Richard Fisher. Following discussion, the question was called for and the motion carried.

The meeting was adjourned and closed with prayer by Pastor Coon.
