in consideration of **FIVE HUNDRED AND NO/100THS (\$500.00)**-----Dollars,

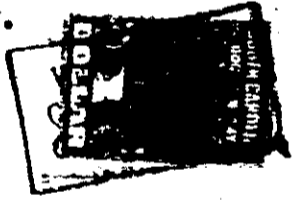
