

(the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by

these presents do grant. bargain, sell and release unto the said The South Carolina State Highway Department, its successors and assigns:

____ in hand paid at and before the sealing of these presents

County. State of South Carolina with all improvements thereon situate, lying and being on the eastern side of Grove Road (Hwy. #225) near the City of Greenville, and having, according to plat of property of A. B. Murrell prepared by W. J. Riddle, Surveyor, in October, 1948, the following metes and bounds, to-wit:

BEGINNING at an iron pin on the eastern side of Grove Road (Hwy. #225) at corner of property of A. B. Murrell (or formerly) and running thence S. 58-53 E. 244.3 feet to a stake; thence N. 25-10 E. 291 feet to an iron pin in a road; thence with said road N. 68-20 W. 240.8 feet to a stake in Grove Road (Hwy. #225); thence with the eastern side of said Grove Road (Hwy. #225) S. 25-40 W. 251.5 feet to an iron pin at the beginning corner.

The abovedescribed property is the identical property conveyed by A. B. Murrell to Maggie M. Roach and C. J. Roach by deed dated October 12, 1948 and recorded in Deed Volume 363 at Page 325, R.M.C. Office for Greenville County, South Carolina. According to the Probate Court records, C. J. Roach died intestate on November 3, 1958, leaving his widow, Maggie M. Roach, and his two daughters, Betty R. Boheler and Nancy R. Warren, as his sole surviving heirs at law. (See Apartment 694, File 23, Probate Court for Greenville County, South Carolina)
