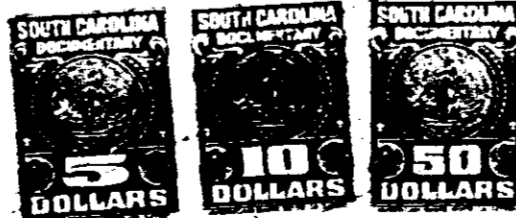

ALL that certain piece, parcel or lot of land, situate, lying and being in the City of Greenville, County of Greenville, State of South Carolina, on the southwestern side of Ponce de Leon Drive and being known and designated as Lot No. 10, as shown on plat of Lanneau Drive, Highlands, recorded in the R.M.C.
