**ALL** that certain piece, parcel or lot of land situate, lying and being in Greenville County, South Carolina, being known and designated as Lot No. 176 of Super-Highway Home Sites, filed in the Register of Mesne Conveyance for Greenville County in Plat Book P, at page 53, and having according to said plat, the following metes and bounds, to-wit:

**BEGINNING** at a point on the northern side of Meridian Avenue, 85 feet from radius on Artillery Road, and running thence along Meridian Avenue, S. 54-33 W. 78 feet to an iron pin; thence N. 38-57 W., 146.5 feet to iron pin on southern side of Warehouse Court; thence along said Warehouse Court, N. 55-0 E., 85 feet to an iron pin; thence S. 34-13 E. 145.8 feet to the point of beginning.
