

12. It is agreed between the parties that neither will from this time forth molest, harrass, hinder or bother the other in any way, shape or form, or attempt to exercise any authority or control, direct or indirect, over the other.

13. It is agreed between the parties that should a divorce proceeding at any time hereafter be instituted, that the terms of this agreement may be entered as a part of any decree entered therein should the parties hereto so desire and should the same be deemed to be necessary by the Court in said cause and for that purpose the proposed decree, before the said decree is submitted to Court, shall be submitted to counsel for each party hereto for examination and alterations as necessary so as to properly incorporate the terms of this agreement as set forth herein before the same is submitted to the Court for final approval and signature.

14. Each party shall at all times keep the other informed of his or her place of residence, and shall promptly notify the other of any change, giving the address of the new place or residence.

15. This agreement shall take effect at such time as both parties have properly executed same.
