1. RULES GOVERNING CEMETERY LOT OWN-ERSHEP. Lots purchased in Gracelard Genuetery are conveyed by Warranty Dred to the purchaser for his family and hefts, as a hurial place forever.

In order that the Corporation may have a correct record of ownership of all lots where a re-sale and conveyance is made, it is required that the recorded deed shall be presented at its office so that a record of the transfer can be made. A fee of \$2.00 will be collected before any transfer of ownership is made on the Corporation's records. The Corporation is governed by its own records as to ownership of lots.

Where a lot is purchased and an extension of time is granted by the Corporation for payment, the Corporation reserves the right to remove the remains which may be interred on the lot, to a smaller lot equal in value to the amount paid on the original, or to a single grave in the event that a default occurs in the agrave is to be opened, containing the name, sex and residence of the deceased, and a permit from the loard of Health must be shown the Superintendent of the grounds before interment is made. If interment is to be made in the forencon, application must be made before 2 oclock p. in, on the previous day. If in the alternoon, by the clock a, in, on the same

Lat owners shall at once notify the Corporation of any change in his or her post office address or name. No disinterment shall be allowed except upon order of the Executive Officers of the Corporation, and upon the written order of the owner or owners of the lot, and in every case can only be made under the supervision of the Superintendent.

The Corporation shall have the right at all times to

the Superintendent.

The Corporation shall have the right at all those to enter upon each and every lot for the purpose of maintaining, cleaning, and policing it.

The Corporation from time to time may lay out or alter such avenues or walks, or make such rules and regulations for the government of the grounds as it may down requisite or proper to promote the general objects of the cemetery.

No consent or approval of the Corporation shall be valid or binding unless the same shall be in writing over the signature of an Executive officer.
