KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS that Frances Sparks, for and in consideration of the sum of Three Thousand and no/100 (\$3,000.00) Dollars to her in hand paid by the South Carolina State Highway Department, the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, has for herself, her successors and assigns, released, acquitted and discharged and by these presents does hereby release, acquit and forever discharge the South Carolina State Highway Department, its agents, employees, and its contractor who performed the actual work on this project of and from all actions, causes of action, claims, damages or demands of whatever name or nature or in any manner having arisen or arising out of the acquisition of the right-of-way obtained in this condemnation proceeding and more specifically designated in the amended notice of condemnation, or to grow out of the construction, reconstruction and maintenance of File 23.651, Route 414, Greenville County, South Carolina, Project A-651, Tract 24, across and adjacent to the property of the landowner. This release intends to and does hereby cover all past, present or prospective damages which might be claimed or result from the acquisition of the right-of-way, construction, reconstruction and maintenance of the subject project including construction, reconstruction and maintenance of drainage facilities as they now exist.

It is further acknowledged that there is no agreement or promise on the part of the South Carolina State Highway Department to do or admit to do any act or thing not herein mentioned and that the above consideration is in full settlement of any and all damages to the undersigned, her successors and assigns, arising from or out of any and all matters before mentioned.
