the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold, and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto LILLIAN S. BROWN, her heirs and assigns forever:

ALL MY RIGHT, TITLE AND INTEREST, THE SAME BEING AN UNDIVIDED ONE-NINTH INTEREST IN AND TO THE FOLLOWING DESCRIBED PROPERTY:

ALL that piece, parcel or lot of land, situate, lying and being in the State of South Carolina, County of Greenville, Greenville Township, being known and designated as parts of Lots 13 and 14 as shown on plat of Sans Souci Villa, plat of subdivision of Suburban Land Company, being recorded in the R.M.C. Office for Greenville County, South Carolina, in Plat Book A at Pages 510 and 511 and having, according to said plat, the following metes and bounds:

BEGINNING at an iron pin on the western side of Brockman Avenue 56.21 feet from the southern side of Young Street at the corner of lot heretofore conveyed by F. E. Major to Texie Coggins and running thence with Coggins line, N. 56-25 W. 175 feet to a stake; thence S. 10-30 W. 56.21 feet to a stake on Brockman Avenue; thence with Brockman Avenue, N. 10-30 E. 51.21 feet to the beginning corner. Said lot is shown on the County Tax Maps at Sheet 163, Block 6, Lot 5.

This conveyance is subject to all restrictions, set-back lines, roadways, zoning ordinances, easements and rights of way, if any, affecting the above described property.

This is the identical property conveyed to John Henry Brown and Lillian S. Brown by Deed of F. M. Osteen dated April 28, 1965, and recorded in the R.M.C. Office for Greenville County, South Carolina, in Deed Book 772 at Page 184. The said John Henry Brown died intestate leaving the Grantor herein as one of his heirs at law.
