the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, HAVE GRANTED, bargained, sold and released, and by these Presents DO GRANT, bargain, sell and release unto the said Administrator of Veterans' Affairs, an Officer of the United States of America, whose principal office and post office address is Veterans' Administration, Washington 25, D. C., and his successors in such office, as such and assigns:

ALL that certain piece, parcel, or lot of land in the County of Greenville, State of South Carolina, on the northerly side of Havendale Drive, being shown and designated as Lot No. 17, on plat of Stonewood which is recorded in the RMC Office for Greenville County, South Carolina, in Plat Book 4-F, at Page 16.

Said lot fronts on the northerly side of Havendale Drive 100 feet, has a uniform depth of 200 feet, and is 100 feet in width across the rear.
