KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, that we, James Ernest Smith and Susie B. Smith, residents of the County and State aforesaid, having previously given a Power of Attorney to our son, Oscar E. Smith, and

WHEREAS, we are desirous of revoking said Power of Attorney insofar as Oscar E. Smith is concerned and substituting our daughters, Betsy S. Hendricks and Mary S. West as our attorneys in fact.

NOW, THEREFORE, we, the said James Ernest Smith and Susie B. Smith, do hereby revoke the Power of Attorney previously granted by us to Oscar E. Smith, dated February 14, 1975 and recorded February 18, 1975 in the R.M.C. Office for Greenville County, South Carolina under No. 19171 and 19172 in the same fashion as if said Power of Attorney had never been granted.

NOW, THEREFORE, we, James Ernest Smith and Susie B. Smith of Greenville, South Carolina, hereby appoint our daughters, Betsy S. Hendricks and Mary S. West, our true and lawful attorneys to act in, manage and conduct all our affairs, and for that purpose in our name and on my behalf and execute any or all of the following acts, deeds and things, that is to say:

1. To ask, demand, sue for, recover and receive all sums of money, debts, dues, goods, wares, merchandise, chattels, effects and things of whatsoever nature or description which now are or hereafter shall be or become due, owing, payable or belonging to me in or by any right, title, ways, or means howsoever, and upon receipt thereof or of any part thereof to make, sign, execute, and deliver such receipts, releases or other discharges for the same respectively as they shall think fit or be advised.

2. To settle any account or reckoning whatsoever wherein I now am or at any time hereafter shall be in any wise interested or concerned with any person whomsoever, and to pay or receive the balance thereof as the case may require.

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S.S.S. 3. To receive every sum of money which now is or hereafter shall be due or belonging to me upon the security or by virtue of any mortgage and on receipt of the full amount secured thereby to execute a good and sufficient release or other discharge of such mortgage by deed or otherwise.

4. To compound with or make allowances to any person or in respect to any debt or demand whatsoever which now is or shall at any time hereafter become due and payable to me, and to take and

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
