> ALL that certain piece, parcel or tract of land, together with buildings and improvements thereon, situate, lying and being on the eastern side of Augusta Road (U. S. Highway No. 25) and the southern side of Lydia Street near the City of Greenville in Greenville County, South Carolina, being shown and designated as Tract No. 6 on plat of Redeemer Heights, property of W. J. Sullivan dated October, 1951, by W. J. Riddle, Surveyor, recorded in the Greenville County RMC Office in Plat Book GG, page 19, and having, according to said plat, the following metes and bounds, to-wit:
