

line of Transcontinental's most northwesterly presently existing pipe line, being the 30 inch pipe line construction in the year 1950. During the periods of original construction of additional pipe lines and maintenance or replacement of existing pipe lines, Transcontinental shall have the right to clear and use, as temporary work space only, a reasonable area adjoining said permanent right of way.

- 2. Grantor shall make no use of said 152 foot right of way which would affect or endanger Transcontinental's pipe lines or interfere with the construction of additional pipe lines.

For and in consideration of the premises, Grantor does hereby grant, bargain, sell and convey unto Transcontinental, its successors and assigns, a right-of-way and easement in accordance with the terms and provisions of said Original Agreement as herein amended; as herein amended said Original Agreement is fully ratified and confirmed by the parties hereto and shall be binding upon and inure to the benefit of the successors and assigns of each. This agreement applies only to that part of the lands described in the Original Agreement which is presently owned by the Grantor.
