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shall do or cause to be done in pursuance hereof after such revocation as aforesaid shall be valid and effectual in favor of any person claiming the benefit thereof who before the doing thereof shall not have had notice of such revocation.

This Power of Attorney shall be revoked by death or revocation by any of us in writing. It shall not be revoked by our physical or mental incapacities.
