the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold, and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto John H. May, III, his heirs and assigns forever:

ALL that certain lot of land in Butler Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina, located on the Old Spartanburg Road and known and designated as Lot No. 6 according to survey made by J. C. Hill, Engineer, entitled Property of B. J. Trammell, recorded in Plat Book FF, at page 43, having the following metes and bounds, to-wit:
