PERSONALLY APPEARED before me Thomas
 A. Babb who being duly sworn says:

I am an Attorney-at-Law practicing in
 Laurens County, South Carolina.

In connection with examining title to
 certain lands in Laurens County, I have determined that two (2)
 deeds were not recorded. One of these deeds is from J. H. and
 Cynthia Babb to Mary A. Gray, dated the 9th day of March, 1909.
 The other deed is by Cynthia Babb in favor of J. H. Babb, also dated
 the 9th day of March, 1909.

Based upon an examination of the re-
 cords and other information available to me, the interest of
 Cynthia Babb in these lands was obtained by inheritance from her
 father Sampson Babb whose last Will and Testament was proved in
 common form on the 25th day of July, 1881, and entered of record
 in Will Book B, at Page 510, in the office of the Probate Judge
 for Laurens County, South Carolina. The interest of J. H. Babb
 was acquired under the terms of deeds from Eunice A. Gray and
 Amanda Champman, recorded respectively in Deed Book W, at Page
 453, and Deed Book W, at Page 455, each on the 8th day of November,
 1881, in the office of the Clerk of Court for Laurens County,
 South Carolina. The said Eunice A. Gray and Amanda Champman
 were daughters and devisees of the said Sampson Babb.
