

release and discharge of Trustee with respect to the administration of the Trustee property, insofar as such administration is reflected in such account, for the period covered by such account.

SECTION THIRTEEN

BOND OF TRUSTEE; LIMITATION OF TRUSTEE'S LIABILITY

No bond shall be required of Trustee or any successor to Trustee. Furthermore, no Trustee appointed hereunder shall at any time be held liable for any action or default in connection with the administration of the trust estate, unless caused by gross negligence of Trustee or an agent of Trustee or by willful commission by Trustee or an agent of Trustee of an act in breach of trust.

SECTION FOURTEEN

GOVERNING LAW

This agreement shall be governed, and its provisions construed, by the law of the State of South Carolina.
