the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold, and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto William E. Cox, his heirs and assigns:

All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land on the East side of Whitney Street, in the village of S. Slater & Sons, Inc. at Slater, in the County of Greenville, State of South Carolina, being known and designated as Lot No. 2 of Block A, as shown on a Plat of the village of S. Slater & Sons, Inc., made by J. E. Sirrine & Company, Engineers, July 10, 1940, which plat is recorded in the R. M. C. Office for Greenville County, in Plat Book K at pages 63, 64 and 65, and having, according to said plat, the following metes and bounds, to wit:

Beginning at an iron pin on the east side of Whitney Street (formerly Hoover Street) joint front corner of Lots no. 2 and 3 of Block A, and running thence with the line of Lot no. 3, N 41-48 E 125 feet to an iron pin; thence 41-46 E 85 feet to an iron pin; thence joint rear corner of Lots No. 1 and 2; thence with the line of Lot no. 1, S 50-57 W 125 feet to an iron pin on the East side of Whitney Street; thence with Whitney Street, N 41-07 W 65 feet to the beginning corner.

This being the same property conveyed to Fred C. Cox, Sr., by deed of W. E. Cox on November 24, 1953, recorded in Book 489 at page 323, in the R. M. C. Office for Greenville County, South Carolina.
