And I, the said Magdeleine Couston hereby ratify and confirm and promise at all times to ratify and confirm all and whatsoever my attorney shall lawfully do or cause to be done in and about the premises by virtue of these presents, including anything which shall be done between the revocation of these presents by my death or in any other manner and notice of such revocation reaching my attorney; and I hereby declare that as against me and all persons claiming under me everything which my attorney shall do or cause to be done in pursuance hereof after such revocation as aforesaid shall be valid and effectual in favor of any person claiming the benefit thereof who before the doing thereof shall not have had notice of such revocation.

If James M. Shoemaker, Jr. should die while serving as my attorney-in-fact or should fail or refuse to accept this appointment for any reason, I hereby nominate, constitute and appoint David L. Freeman my attorney-in-fact in his stead with all the powers and duties hereinabove set forth to be enjoyed or performed by my attorney-in-fact herein named.

This Power of Attorney shall be revoked by death or revocation by me in writing. It shall not be revoked by my physical or mental incapacity.
