

and 259, and being known and designated as Lot No. 2 as shown on a more recent plat prepared by John C. Smith, dated May, 1950, and having according to a plat prepared by J. Mac Richardson, dated February 17, 1960, entitled "Property of Leslie & Shaw, Inc.," recorded in the RMC Office for Greenville County, South Carolina, in Plat Book TT at page 130, the following metes and bounds:

BEGINNING at an iron pin on the westerly side of Julian Avenue, which iron pin is located 236.5 feet in a Southeasterly direction from the intersection of New Dunham Bridge Road and Julian Avenue at the joint corner of Lots Nos. 1 and 2, and running thence with the line of Lot No. 1 South 52-30 West 305 feet to an iron pin on the easterly side of the New Dunham Bridge Road at the joint corner of Lots Nos. 22 and 23 as shown on the first above mentioned plat; thence with the line of property now or formerly of Otis Orr, South 83-08 East 149.6 feet to an iron pin at the joint corner of Lots Nos. 2 and 3; thence with the line of Lot No. 3 North 55-30 East 185 feet to an iron pin on the Westerly side of Julian Avenue; thence with the Westerly side of Julian Avenue North 31-05 West 115 feet to the point of BEGINNING."

This is the identical property conveyed to the Trustees of Julian Avenue Baptist Church by Leslie & Shaw, Inc. by deed dated February 18, 1960, recorded in the RMC Office for Greenville County in Deed Book 644 at page 538.

The Trustees of Julian Avenue Baptist Church changed the name of the church to Tanglewood Baptist Church on or about January 1, 1973 and this deed is prepared in order to vest the fee simple title in Tanglewood Baptist Church according to the records of Greenville County, South Carolina.
