

and privileges of any and every kind in and to such books, plays, dramatic compositions, musical compositions, acts and scenes, and to sell, lease, license or otherwise dispose of any of the same.

(d) To purchase, lease, rent, construct, erect or otherwise acquire, and to hold, own, let and/or otherwise dispose of theatres, motion picture and vaudeville houses, concert halls, music halls, opera houses, office buildings, or other structures, and any right or interests therein, as may seem necessary, useful or incidental to the proper accomplishment of any of the purposes of the corporation.

(e) To manufacture, purchase or otherwise acquire, own, mortgage, pledge, sell, assign and transfer, or otherwise dispose of, to invest, trade, deal in and deal with goods, wares and merchandise and real or personal property of every class and description.

(f) To acquire and pay for, in cash, stock or bonds of this corporation, or otherwise, the good will, rights, assets and property, and to undertake, guarantee, endorse or assume the whole or any part of the obligations or liabilities, including leases and all other contracts of any other person, firm, association or corporation.

(g) To acquire, hold, use, sell, assign, lease, grant licenses in respect of, mortgage or otherwise dispose of letters patent of the United States or any foreign country, patent rights, licenses and privileges, inventions, improvements and processes, copyrights, trade marks and trade names relating to or useful in connection with any business of this corporation.

(h) To manufacture, distribute, exchange, purchase, buy, own, prepare, take, import, sell, export, present, let, lease, or license others to use, motion pictures, features, feature films, photographic film, both negative and positive, of objects in motion
