East Stone Ave. to East North Street (Name of Place)

Spartanburg Street
Shown by plans prepared by the City of Greenville on and over all land which I (or we) own and are furtherdescribed below, for the purpose of locating, constructing improving, and maintaining the above described highway with the bridges and causeways thereon, and the right to construct and maintain controlled access facilities to said highway:

DERIVATION: Vol. 466, page 421, recorded Nov. 13, 1952 from Central Realty Corp. Said property is described as follows:

BEGINNING at a point at the joint rear corner of Lots 52 and 53 and running thence S. 39-25 W. 50 feet, more or less, to a point on the northern side of Spartanburg Street; thence with the Northern side of Spartanburg Street N. 66-59 W. 75 feet, more or less, to a point; thence N. 39-25 E. 70 feet, more or less, to a point at the joint rear corner of Lots 53 and 54; thence S. 50-35 E. 70 feet, more or less, to the point of beginning. See Plat Book P, page 130-131.

Said right-of-way is described as follows: BEGINNING at a point on the northern side of Spartanburg Street joint front corner of lots 28 and 6 running thence in a westerly direction along the northern side of Spartanburg Street N. 66-59 W. 75 feet, more or less, to a side line N. 39-25 E., such easement or right-of-way shall contain any and all portions of the parcel within 16 feet of a centerline of Spartanburg Street as shown on a plat prepared by W. R. Williams, RE & LS, October 1976 and filed in the RMC Office of the County of Greenville. Plat Book SX at page 11-24.

"Special Provisions:" The City assures that it will move the fence at the rear of the subject property if this becomes necessary to maintain stability.

Together with, all and singular, the rights, members, hereditaments and appurtenances thereunto belonging, or in any wise incident or appertaining. It is agreed that buildings, fences, signs or other obstructions will not be erected by me (or us), my heirs, assigns or administrators within the limits of the right-of-way herein conveyed and that such buildings and fences as are now within the limits of the right-of-way herein conveyed will be moved from the right-of-way and restored in as good condition as before moving at the expense of the City of Greenville, South Carolina.

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD, all and singular, the said right-of-way and the rights herein before granted, unto the said City of Greenville, its successors and assigns forever.
