Upon consideration of the Application of Cornelius Leaton, dated June 30, 1978, for authority to abandon certain real property of the bankrupt K & B Enterprises Co., Inc., and it appearing that such property has no realizable value to this estate, and no adverse interest being represented, it is

ORDERED that the trustee do, and he hereby is, authorized to abandon the following described property of the bankrupt to K & B Enterprises Co., Inc.:

All that piece, parcel or lot of land with all improvements thereon or hereafter constructed thereon, situated, lying and being in the town of Taylors, County of Greenville, State of South Carolina on the southerly side of old U. S. Highway No. 21 and having according to a plat prepared by Campbell & Harrison, Surveyors dated December 31, 1968, the following lots or parcels, to-wit:

Lot 11 - at or near the southerly side of old U. S. Highway 21, which iron pin is the point corner of property of the trustee and the main memorial Methodist Church and is a distance along old U. S. Highway 21, S. 32-33 of 15 feet to a point; thence S. 37-38 of 13.2 feet to a point; thence S. 38-39 of 13.1 feet to a point; thence S. 43-44 of 12.7 feet to a point; thence S. 45-46 of 12.3 feet to a point; thence S. 52-53 of 13.7 feet to a point; thence S. 35-23 of 15.5 feet to a point; thence S. 21-22 of 13.2 feet to the point of beginning.
