KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, that I, CHARLES E. WARE

In consideration of THIRTY SEVEN THOUSAND and No/100-----(\$37,000.00)----- Dollars,
the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold, and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell
and release unto SOUTH CAROLINA STATE HIGHWAY DEPARTMENT, its successors and assigns:

ALL that certain lot of land situate, lying and being in the City of Greenville, County of Greenville, State of South Carolina, located on Hampton Avenue, being shown as Lot No. 13 of Block 1 on Page 22 of the City Block Book, and being more fully described as follows:

BEGINNING at a pin on the northeast side of Hampton Avenue, located 69 feet from the intersection of Echols Street, and running thence with said Avenue in a southeasterly direction 69 feet to a stake; thence N. 51-45 E. 168.5 feet to a stake; thence N. 41-45 W. 61 feet to a stake; thence S. 54-00 W. 169 feet to the point of beginning.

This is the identical property conveyed to Charles E. Ware and Evelyn E. Ware by deed of Alice Jane Tatum Townsend dated October 27, 1961, and recorded November 1, 1961, in Greenville County Deed Book 685 at Page 346. Thereafter, Evelyn E. Ware departed this life on March 2, 1968, dying intestate at Greenville County, South Carolina, and leaving her husband, Charles E. Ware, and her daughter, Patricia W. Wright, a/k/a Patricia W. Galloway, as her sole heirs at law. No other children were ever born to or adopted by the said Evelyn E. Ware. By deed dated February 9, 1978, and recorded February 14, 1978, the said Patricia W. Wright, a/k/a Patricia W. Galloway, conveyed her interest in said property to the Grantor herein, said deed being recorded in Greenville County Deed Book 1073 at Page 612.

This conveyance is subject to all restrictions, setback lines, roadways, zoning ordinances, easements and rights of way, if any, affecting the above described property.
