And I hereby declare that any act or thing lawfully done hereunder by my said attorneys shall be binding on myself and my heirs, legal and personal representatives, and assigns.

This general power of attorney shall not be affected by physical disability or mental incompetence of the principal which renders the principal incapable or managing his own estate.
