RENUNCIATION OF DOWER

That heretofore, by deed dated March 20, 1942, and recorded in the R.M.C. Office for Greenville County on March 20, 1942 in Deed Book 243, Page 217, Otis E. Ridgeway conveyed the property hereinbelow described to Otis E. Ridgeway, Jr., and

That the aforementioned deed of conveyance contained a Renunciation of Dower by Thelma W. Ridgeway wife of Otis E. Ridgeway, which Renunciation of Dower by inadvertence, was executed in favor of J. W. Norwood instead of in favor of the grantee, Otis E. Ridgeway, Jr., and

That the aforesaid J. W. Norwood had no right, title or interest in and to the property hereinbelow described or in and to the deed from Otis E. Ridgeway to Otis E. Ridgeway, Jr. and that it was the intent and purpose of Thelma W. Ridgeway to renounce her dower in favor of her son, Otis E. Ridgeway, Jr.

That heretofore, by deed dated September 16, 1943 and recorded on September 17, 1943 in the R.M.C. Office for Greenville County in Deed Book 256, Page 360, James P. Moore conveyed the property hereinbelow described to A. B. Howard and Mollie Howard as Trustees; and

That the aforementioned deed from James P. Moore contained a Renunciation of Dower by his wife, Rose Morgan Moore, but that said Renunciation of Dower failed to contain and set forth the name of any party to whom the renunciation of dower was executed in favor of; and

That it was the intent and purpose of Rose Morgan Moore that she renounce her dower interest in and to the property described hereinbelow in favor of the grantees in said deed,

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
