TO WHOM IT MAY CONCERN:

Notice is hereby given that Greenville County Council has filed a petition in the above court under the Public Works Eminent Domain Law to acquire by condemnation a drainage easement over and across the following described real property:

All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land in Butler Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina, being known and designated as lot # 3, on a plat of the property of T. L. Greene made by Dalton & Neves, August, 1959, recorded in Plat Book TT at Page 198, RMC Office for Greenville County, and having, according to said plat, the following metes and bounds, to-wit:

BEGINNING at an iron pin on the western side of Monterey Lane, corner of lot # 2, thence with the line of said lot, S. 86-09 W. 251.9 feet to an iron pin; thence S. 2-53 W. 175.8 feet to an iron pin on Biscayne Drive; thence with said Drive, and around the curve to the left, the chord of which is S. 57-05 E. 50.1 feet to an iron pin on Monterey Lane; thence with said Lane, S. 63-15 E. 180.3 feet to iron pin; thence with said lane, N. 47-41 E. 30.3 feet to an iron pin; thence with said lane, and around a curve to the left, the chord of which is N. 25-55 E. 74 feet to an iron pin; thence with said lane, N. 2-24 E. 52 feet to the beginning.

A plat of said easement, showing the location and dimensions thereof, is attached hereto.

Notice is further given that on June 19, 1979 at 2:30 P.M. there will be a hearing before the Honorable James H. Price, Jr., Resident Judge of the Thirteenth Judicial Circuit, in the Greenville County Courthouse for:
