PARTIAL RELEASE OF LEASE AND OF MORTGAGE

R. Mesenbrink, as Trustee, said W. R. Mesenbrink having been succeeded as Individual Trustee by G. E. Maier, which assignment is recorded in Book 1024, Page 481, in the office of the Recorder of the above named county and state.
