KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, That JAMES D. HOLAWAY, a resident of Greenville County, South Carolina; (hereinafter called "Grantor"), for and in consideration of the sum of Love and Affection

(hereinafter called "Grantee") in the State aforesaid, (the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged) has granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these Presents does grant, bargain, sell and release, unto the Grantee, his heirs, successors and assigns: forever:

ALL THAT CERTAIN PIECE, PARCEL OR LOT OF GROUND, together with all the buildings and improvements thereon; situated in the County of Greenville, State of South Carolina, in O'Neal Township; approximately Three (3) miles North of Greer, S. C. on the South side of Lake Road; according to a survey and map by H. S. Brockman Surveyor, dated July 17, 1972, registered in Plat Book SSS, page No. 635, Records of RMC Office of Greenville County, S. C.; said property being more particularly described as follows:

BEGINNING at a point on the center line of Lake Road near the intersection of the center line of Ansel School Road and running South 10 degrees 30 minutes East, Two hundred sixty one and six tenths (261.6') feet to an iron pin; then South 83 degrees 55 minutes West, One hundred forty nine and seven tenths (149.7') feet to an iron pin in a gully; then along the gully North 19 degrees 06 minutes West, One hundred eighty eight (188.0') feet to a point; then North 6 degrees 35 minutes West, One hundred two and 8 tenths (102.8') feet to a point in the center of Lake Road; then along the center line of Lake Road South 87 degrees 49 minutes East, One hundred seventy four and eight tenths (174.8') feet to the point of beginning.
