GENERAL POWER OF ATTORNEY

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS that I, the undersigned,
do hereby appoint

EDWARD L. SMITH

my attorney-in-fact, in my name, in any way which I myself could do if I were personally present, to demand, sue for, and receive all sums of money from whatsoever sources due to me at any time; to contract in reference to, or purchase or sell personal or real property, upon such terms as said attorney-in-fact shall see fit. Also to transact every kind of business, to sign and deliver all instruments in writing of whatever kind as may be involved in such transactions. Without limiting the foregoing I specifically empower my attorney-in-fact to execute, endorse, deposit, withdraw or otherwise perform all banking transactions in my name, and to execute every act whatsoever in reference to stocks, bonds, investments, corporate rights, and transactions, and all insurance transactions, and personal relationships and affairs.

This appointment is irrevocable and all persons or corporations may rely upon this instrument at any time hereafter. I hereby estop myself, my heirs or assigns, from contesting in any way any transaction or act by my said attorney-in-fact performed pursuant to the terms of this instrument, and bind myself to indemnify all persons or corporations against any loss resulting solely from acceptance of or reliance upon this instrument in dealing with my attorney-in-fact. I do also hereby ratify and confirm all that my attorney-in-fact shall do or cause to be done by virtue of this instrument. No person or corporation shall be required to inquire beyond the terms of this instrument, nor to trace or be responsible for the distribution of any funds paid to my attorney-in-fact on my behalf.

A copy of this instrument certified as true and accurate by a Notary Public shall be sufficient basis for reliance upon the original thereof by any person or corporation dealing with my said attorney-in-fact.

This power of attorney shall not be affected by physical disability or mental incompetence of the principal which renders the principal incapable of managing the principal's own estate. It is my intention that this power of attorney fulfill all of the requirements of Section 32-13-10, Code of Laws of SC, 1976.
