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this action.

2. Respondents are all of the present owners and holders of the property described and shown on the above mentioned plat of Evins Road. Respondents are also all of the present property owners whose property abuts and adjoins such proposed road to be closed and are all of the present owners through whose land such Evins Road traverses.

3. The Petitioner pursuant to Code Section 57-9-10 of the 1976 Code of Laws of South Carolina, as amended, have published the requisite "Notice of Intention to File" once a week for the three consecutive weeks prior to the filing of this petition in the Greenville Piedmont, a newspaper published in the County where such road is situate, such notice having been published on December 13, December 20, and December 27, 1980. Notice was mailed requiring a return receipt to each of the Respondents representing all of the abutting property owners whose property would be affected by such change.

4. It is in the best interest of Petitioner, Respondents, and any other party or parties who might be concerned that such road be abandoned and closed.

5. Title to such road lies in the present fee simple owner or owners, of each tract of property through which said road passes. No such road acts as a property or dividing line between property owned by more than one person. Title to said abandoned and closed road should revert directly to the present fee owner or owners of land through it passes.

NOW, THEREFORE, it is hereby ordered, adjudged and decreed that:

- 1. Evins Road as shown on the above referenced plat shall be legally and formally closed and abandoned;
- 2. All interests of Petitioner, Respondents and the public, if any, in such road is hereby extinguished;
- 3. Title to such road lies in the present fee simple owner or owners of each tract of property through which said road passes;
- 4. The Register of Mesne Conveyance of Greenville County,

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
