

2. An undivided interest in the property owned in common which shall appertain to each residence owner shall be the percentage of undivided interest previously owned by such owner in the common areas and facilities;

3. Any liens affecting any of the residences shall be deemed to be transferred in accordance with the existing priorities to the percentage of the undivided interest of the residence owner in the property; and,

4. The property shall be subject to an action for partition at the suit of any residence owners, in which event the net proceeds of sale shall be paid to the Insurance Trustee. Such net proceeds of sale together with the net proceeds of the insurance on the property shall be considered as one fund and shall be divided among all the residence owners in shares equal to the fractional shares of undivided interest owned by each owner in the property (taking into account a residence owner's increased share by reason of a "betterments" increase or endorsement). To the extent sufficient for the purpose, a residence owner's share shall first be paid to satisfy any lien on the undivided interest in the property owned by such residence owner.
