KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, that Enid Owen, Marion T. Mathis, Cecil Nelson, Administrator CTA for Estate of Annie McHugh Bright, Minnie M. McHugh, sole heir for Malvin McHugh, and Pauline McHugh Woodside

in consideration of (\$37,500.00) Thirty-seven Thousand Five Hundred and no/100----- Dollars,

the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold, and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto William Berry Parks, his heirs and assigns, forever: all my right, title and interest to the following described property, to-wit:

ALL that certain piece, parcel or lot of land situate, lying and being in the State and County aforesaid, in Ward One of the City of Greenville, being known and designated as the Western half of Lot No. 46, of Section "B", of the property belonging to the Stone Land Company, as shown on plat recorded in the R.M.C. Office for Greenville County, in Plat Book "A", at page 339, and having, according to said plat, the following metes and bounds, to-wit:

BEGINNING at a point on the North side of West Croft Street, 200 feet Eastward from the Northeast corner of Croft and Townes Streets, and running thence along Croft Street S. 83-13 E. 50 feet to a stake; thence N. 1-41 E. 200 feet to a stake on the South side of an alley; thence along the South side of said alley, N. 83-13 W. 50 feet to a stake; thence S. 1-41 W. 200 feet to a stake on the North side of West Croft Street, the point of beginning, being the same property conveyed to the grantor by deed of George D. Lee, by deed dated February 11, 1936, and recorded in the R.M.C. Office for Greenville County on the same date in Deed Book 184 at Page 45.

Said P. W. McHugh died testate on November 21, 1965. His estate being administered by the Probate Court of Greenville County in Apartment 927 File 6, leaving a life estate to Peola McHugh with the remainder to his nieces and nephews: Mary Mathis, Annie McHugh Bright, Malvin McHugh, Pauline McHugh Woodside, Virginia Bramlett Black, H. T. Bramlett, Lucille McHugh Bushae and Ruby McHugh Nabors aka Neighbors. Thereafter, the said Mary Mathis died intestate, her estate being administered in the Probate Court for Greenville County in Apartment 1331 File 48. The said Mary Mathis leaving her sole heirs at law, Ella Mae Miller, Marion T. Mathis, Jr., Marvin Reese Mathis, and Ruby E. Owen aka Enid Owen. The said Annie McHugh Bright died testate on May 26, 1981, her estate being administered in the Probate Court for Greenville County in Apartment 1660 File 7, naming Pauline Woodside as Executrix with full power to sell. Said Pauline Woodside thereafter resigning and appointing Cecil H. Nelson, Jr., Attorney at Law, to fulfill her responsibilities as Executrix. Said Malvin McHugh died intestate leaving his sole heir, his wife, Minnie M. McHugh.
