All that certain piece, parcel or tract of land in Greenville County, State of South Carolina, being known and designated as Tract No. 1 on a plat of Property of James Clifford Smith Estate prepared by T. H. Walker, Jr., dated May 15, 1981, and recorded in the R.M.C. Office for Greenville County, South Carolina, in Plat Book 8N at Page 98, said tract containing 5.053 acres (4.407 acres net). Reference to above plat is hereby craved for a more particular metes and bounds description.

ALSO: All that certain piece, parcel or tract of land in Greenville County, State of South Carolina, being known and designated as Tract No. 2 on a plat of Property of James Clifford Smith Estate prepared by T. H. Walker, Jr., dated May 15, 1981, and recorded in the R.M.C. Office for Greenville County, South Carolina, in Plat Book 8N at Page 98, said tract containing 11.461 acres (10.619 acres net). Reference to above plat is hereby craved for a more particular metes and bounds description.

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This is a portion of the same property conveyed to James Clifford Smith and Grover C. Smith by deed of Cora A. Adair, Ellie S. Tumblin, Essie S. The said James Clifford Smith died testate on June 12, 1979 and by record of his estate in the Office of the Probate Court for Greenville County, South Carolina, in Apartment 1567 at File 18, he devised to his widow, Ruth C.
