BE IT KNOWN THAT I, NORTON E. CATER, grant to, give to and vest in Suzanne S. By way of explanation, and not limitation, my attorney in fact shall have the power to receive and make payments on my behalf; draw, issue and sign checks or drafts on any accounts or make withdrawals from any accounts which I may have at any bank; open or close any accounts at any bank; have access to any safety deposit box which I may have with the right to remove or deposit items in said safety deposit box; to receive and collect mail on my behalf; to make purchases on my behalf; to incur debt on my behalf; to enter into agreements on my behalf; and to do any other act necessary to direct and manage my affairs.

This power of attorney shall not be affected by physical disability or mental incompetence of the principal which renders the principal incapable of managing his own estate.
