

(3) An easement of 20 feet in width across the rear of the property for purposes of an alley, as shown on said plat.

(4) An easement of 16 feet in width between Lots 30 and 31 as shown on the plat referred to hereinabove, said easement of 16 feet being the connection between First Avenue and the 20 foot alley to the rear of the property referred to in restriction (3) above.

Together with all and singular the Rights, Members, Hereditaments and Appurtenances to the said premises belonging or in any wise incident or appertaining.

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD all and singular the premises before mentioned unto the GRANTEE hereinabove named, and its Successors and Assigns forever.
