ALL MY RIGHT, TITLE AND INTEREST IN AND TO THE FOLLOWING DESCRIBED PROPERTY: ALL that certain piece, parcel or lot of land, together with all improvements thereon, situate, lying and being in the County of Greenville, State of South Carolina, about two miles West of the City of Greenville, near the Monaghan Mill, in New Hope Subdivision, said lot being shown and designated as Lot No. Three (3) on plat of New Hope Subdivision, said plat being recorded in the RMC Office for Greenville County, SC in Plat Book A, at Page 307, on October 16, 1909, and having a frontage of 55 feet on Hoyt Street and a depth of 150 feet, reference to said plat being craved for a metes and bounds description thereof.

This conveyance is subject to all restrictions, set-back lines, roadways, zoning ordinances, easements, and rights-of-way, if any, affecting the above described property.

This is the same property conveyed to C.H. Campbell and Falbia S. Campbell by deed of E. Inman, Master, dated February 11, 1946, recorded in the RMC Office for Greenville County, SC in Deed Book 287, at Page 168, on February 16, 1946; the said Falbia S. Campbell died testate in May 31, 1975, devising her one-half undivided interest in and to the subject property to the said C.H. Campbell (See Apartment 1383, File 8, Office of the Probate Judge for Greenville County, SC); the said C.H. Campbell died intestate on December 27, 1981, leaving as his sole heirs-at-law, Carrie G. Campbell, Clifton Joe Campbell, Jerry L. Campbell, Charles W. Campbell, Barbara L. Wall, and Jack L. Campbell (See Apartment 1689, File 5, Office of the Probate Judge for Greenville County, S.C.)

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together with all and singular the rights, members, hereditaments and appurtenances to said premises belonging or in any wise incident or appertaining; to have and to hold all and singular the premises before mentioned unto the grantee(s), and the grantee(s)' heirs or successors and assigns, forever. And, the grantor(s) do(es) hereby bind the grantor(s) and the grantor(s)' heirs or successors, executors and administrators to warrant and forever defend all and singular said premises unto the grantee(s) and the grantee(s)' heirs or successors and assigns against the grantor(s) and the grantor(s)' heirs or successors and against every person whomsoever lawfully claiming or to claim the same or any part thereof.
