personal, during their marriage without the signature or joining in by the other. It is the intention of the Wife to waive, relinquish, and bar all her dower and statutory rights or interest, either as the wife or widow of the Husband, to any property, real, personal, or mixed now owned or hereafter acquired by the Husband and in entering into this Agreement, the Wife acknowledges that the Husband has fully informed her of his financial situation and wealth. The parties declare that they have carefully read this Agreement and have discussed the legal effect thereof, and further, that a full disclosure of the properties of each party has been made to the other.

Through this instrument, the parties intend to mutually release and waive the benefits of the laws of the State of South Carolina relating to husband and wife, dower, homestead and the like, and forever bar each other from any action to recover any interest that may now be or shall hereafter, during the lifetime or at the death of either of the parties hereto, be acquired by the other in the property, both real and personal, of the other.
