

all acts which the Trustee may deem necessary or proper to carry out the purposes of this trust.

(10) Resignation of Trustee and Successor Trustee. Any Trustee at any time acting hereunder may resign at any time by written notice to the Grantor, if living, otherwise Grantor's wife, if living, otherwise the beneficiaries of the trust over the age of twenty-one (21), or, if none, to the parents, guardians, or committees of the beneficiaries who are under disability. Unless otherwise provided for herein, in the event of the resignation, death, or inability to act of any Trustee acting or appointed to act hereunder, Grantor, if living, otherwise Grantor's wife, if living, otherwise a majority in interest of the beneficiaries over the age of twenty-one (21), or, if none, a majority in interest of such parents, guardians, or committees shall appoint a successor Trustee to administer the trusts. Unless otherwise provided herein, no individual shall be appointed successor Trustee of any trust who may benefit by the exercise of any powers given the Trustee, or who has any beneficial interest in any trust created hereunder, whether as an income beneficiary or remainderman, and whether or not such interest is vested or contingent. In addition, unless otherwise provided herein, the Grantor and the Grantor's wife and the Grantor's children may never be appointed as successor Trustee hereunder. Unless otherwise provided herein, any such successor Trustee appointed hereunder shall be completely disinterested from the standpoint of having any direct or indirect beneficial interest in any trust created herein. Any successor Trustee shall be clothed and vested with all the duties, rights, titles, and powers, whether discretionary or otherwise conferred herein, as if originally named as Trustee. No successor Trustee shall be liable or responsible in any way for any acts or defaults of any predecessor Trustee, but such successor Trustee shall be liable only for its own acts and defaults with respect to property actually received by it as such Trustee. The successor Trustee may accept the accounting rendered and the assets and property delivered to it by the predecessor Trustee as a full and complete
