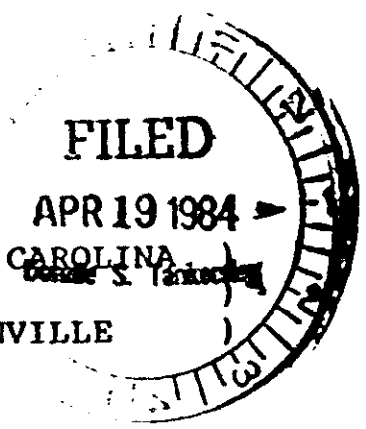

POWER OF ATTORNEY

By way of illustration, but not of limitation, of my attorney's powers, such powers shall include the following: to demand, claim and sue for any amounts due me and receipt for same; to compromise, arbitrate or otherwise adjust claims in favor of or against me; to sell, lease and mortgage real estate and personal property and to execute and deliver such deeds, mortgages, leases, bills of sale, notes, transfers and other instruments in writing as may be deemed advisable; to borrow money and if required to do so, secure the same by collateral or mortgage; to employ counsel and other agents as may be deemed advisable in the handling of my affairs; to write checks on and withdraw from any or all funds which I may have in a checking account, savings account or other type of deposit in any bank, savings and loan association, building and loan association, United States Post Office or elsewhere; to buy, sell and cash any certificates of deposit or other evidence of deposit in any bank, savings and loan association or building and loan association; to participate
