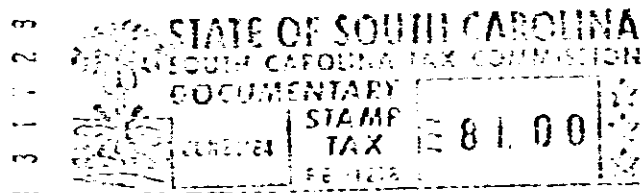
in consideration of Forty Thousand, Five Hundred and 00/100 (\$40,500.00) Dollars,
