POWER OF ATTORNEY

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, that I, WILLIAM HENRY LOCKE, of the County of Greenville, State of South Carolina, do hereby constitute and appoint ANNA M. FLINN of the County of Greenville, State of South Carolina, my true and lawful attorney-in-fact, in my name and stead, for my use and benefit, and as my act and deed, to do and perform, in my said attorney's sole and absolute discretion, as my said attorney deems advisable, all or any of the following acts and deeds, to-wit:

(a) Ask, demand, sue for, recover, collect, and receive all such sums of money, debts, accounts, interest, dividends, annuities, rentals, and demands whatsoever, as now are, or hereafter shall become, due, owing or payable to me; make, execute, and deliver acquittances, receipts, releases, satisfactions, or other discharges therefor; and enforce, deposit, negotiate, and cash any check, draft, money order, or other negotiable instrument made payable to me or to my order;

(b) Purchase or otherwise acquire, and take, receive, hold, and retain any and all stocks, bonds, notes or other securities, or any variety of real or personal property;

(c) Sell, convey, lease, pledge, mortgage, transfer, assign, exchange, convert or otherwise dispose of, or grant options with respect to, any and all real or personal property, of whatever kind, at any time owned by me, in any manner, at any time or times, for any purpose, for any price and upon any terms, credits and conditions;

(d) Borrow money from any lender for any purpose, and as security to mortgage, pledge, or otherwise encumber, upon any terms and conditions, any real or personal property at any time owned by me;

(e) Vote in person or by general or limited proxy, with respect to any shares of stock or other security;

(f) Place and affect insurance of any and every kind of business;

(g) Make, sign, execute, seal, acknowledge, transfer, and deliver any and all instruments to carry out any of the foregoing powers, including, but not limited to, checks, promissory notes, certificates of stock, bonds, deeds, mortgages, leases, assignments, and agreements, no party to any such instrument being required to inquire into its validity or to see to the application of any money or other property

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
